## **RHA Issue Update**

- Re the **PCH Landscape and Fencing Project**, Public Works contacted us this week about the Highway Safety Grant to say that “[we] have been notified that the grant has no fatal flaws...the application is in the final stages of the review process ...we are optimistic and hopeful that we will be hearing a positive response soon.” (ie.,this month)  
This federal grant would provide wrought iron fencing, a guardrail and some landscaping on the PCH corridor from Calle Mayor to Janet Lee Lane (1/2 mile length). We hope that the people living on the frontage road without safety fencing or greenery barrier will soon get some relief.
- **Tree ordinance for the Hillside Overlay** The request for a public hearing on a tree ordinance has stalled in city council. Many of the councilmen are focusing on the coming election. Several of the candidates running for mayor and city council have told us that they are supportive of a tree ordinance for the hillside, saying that it is “timely” and “modest” and “appears to be cost-neutral for the city.” It is definitely going to be an election issue for the April forum and the June, 2014 election!
- **Coyotes** No new coyote attacks on pets have been reported. Pet safety is being left to the pet owner. Do not leave pet food outside, keep pets inside at night, dispose of fruit which falls to the ground, and ensure that all trash cans are lidded.
- **Hillside Overlay cases** RHA board members have been attending Planning Commission meetings, sending letters, making comments at the meetings and advising residents.  
Mrs. “ Mike” Terre of Camino de Arboles says “You’re the greatest! Thank you for your help with my hillside overlay case.”
